

## Rules You Have to Obey While At Camp

1. The Camp Director and leaders will be obeyed at all times.
2. No one is allowed to go outside of the Camp grounds without permission from the Camp Director – period!
3. All mobiles must be turned into either your pastor, or to the Camp Director upon arrival at camp. **Use of mobile phones will be allowed once a day** at lunch-time and will be strictly monitored. If you are using a mobile phone inappropriately, then you risk losing it, and you will lose points for both yourself, and your team. If your parents need to contact you, they can ring either your pastor or the Camp Director.
4. Keep your Camper Handbook, put your name on it – don't lose it!
5. Don't leave your stuff lying around.
6. Keep your hands off other people's stuff.
7. Every meal, a team will be selected to wash the dishes and clean the dining hall – do your tasks without complaining – the better the attitude, the more the points!
8. No profanity will be allowed.
9. No rock music will be played at all at camp.
10. No boy and girl things going on.
11. No knives – if you have one, give it to your pastor, or to the Camp Director until Camp is over and he will return it.
12. No smoking.
13. No going behind the buildings, or going out through the windows.
14. No guys going into girl's rooms, and no girls going into the guy's room – ever!
15. No one except adults are allowed into the Adult rooms.

# How to Earn Points

## Getting Points

- Every Scripture verse you memorize, YOU get 100 points!
- If you memorize all the 5 key verses you get 500 Extra points!
- If you memorize ALL the verses, you will get 1000 extra points on top of them!
- The first full team present and seated for Chapel gets 500 points! Every time!
- Every Team Cheer, or Skit will get points for that team based on how good they are!
- Every time your team wins a sports activity, your whole team gets points! Some sports activities will not be point-based.
- Clean Bunks will result in 100 points being given to the person.
- A completed Bible Word Dictionary will result in 500 points for that person.
- Every Sermon or lesson that you take a full page of notes on will get you 500 pts.
- Every Devotion Page completed will get 500 points.
- Every time the Camp Director sees a person with great zeal, they will get 500 pts.
- Every young camper who finishes making a Craft will get points!
- Every bed at inspection that is clean and tidy will get 100 points.

## Losing Points – unless stated, breaking any of these rules has a limit of three warnings

- Every time someone on your team has a bad attitude, breaks a rule, or gets into a fight, they will lose points.
- Every bed must be made and every room cleaned before breakfast – or else each person who leaves a messy bunk will lose 100 points.
- Arguing with a camp leader/counsellor will cost you 500 points.
- No one ever goes out of the camp unless they are given permission by the Camp Director. If you leave camp grounds without permission, you may be sent home.
- No boy is ever allowed in a girl's room, and no girl is ever allowed in a boy's room. If you disobey this rule, you may be sent home.
- No one is allowed to mess with the windows in the rooms, or with the thermostats. Do not touch the fire alarms!
- Everyone must obey their team leader and the camp counsellors at all times.
- Anyone caught doing intentional damage to the camp will have to pay for it, and may be sent home.
- Anyone going out of their room after curfew or before 6am **will be sent home.**
- Anyone with more than three warnings will be sent home.
- Anyone caught messing with the fire alarms will be sent home!!!!





**Intro:** There are things we shouldn't forget, and some things we should! There are things in our lives that only hold us back from **going forward** for the Lord Jesus Christ. Our focus must be on Him! Be prepared to make some changes if you want to change!







## Wednesday Devotion

### Struggles

**Galatians 5:17** *For the flesh \_\_\_\_\_ against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh: and these are contrary the one to the other: so that ye \_\_\_\_\_ do the things that ye would.*



**Intro:** The wilderness journey is a perfect picture of the Christian trying to get to the place where God can mightily use them. The promised land is not so much a picture of Heaven, but rather, a picture of finding God's will for your life; whereby you can be most used by Him. It is always going to be a struggle to reach that place. Our enemies are the world, the flesh, and the Devil. They don't give up easy. It is only reached through struggling to do right.

### There are Right Struggles!

The Christian life is always going to be an uphill climb, but we are not alone. Our glorious Lord said that he would never leave or forsake us. He is the one that helps us along life's journey.

**Fleshly Appetites**



## Thursday's Devotion

### *How Not to Fail*

**1Cor. 10:13** *There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but God is faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear it.*

**Intro:** God's will for the children of Israel was for all of them to enter into the Promised Land. The Lord commanded Moses to send in spies to search out the land. Only two came back with a good report. Many of the children of Israel DID NOT go into the Promised Land because they chose not to trust God and His word. They died in the wilderness because they FAILED to trust God. God tested them to see if they would trust Him and what He had told them! **Gen.35:12** *And the land which I gave Abraham and Isaac, to thee I will give it, and to thy seed after thee will I give the land.*

\_\_\_\_\_ = a testing, to try, to prove (for good or for evil) as in the enticing of the devil.

- God tests us to see if we will trust Him, and believe His promises! Deut.8:2

**To fail in our walk with God, the key is to trust Him and do right when temptations come.**

- We are told in the Bible not to \_\_\_\_\_ the world. **1John2:15**  
Satan will tempt you to love the world more than you love God what will you do? **Matt.6:24**
- We are told in the Bible not to be a \_\_\_\_\_ of the world. **James 4:4**  
You will be tempted to turn away from the Lord who wants to be your friend.

- We are told in the Bible to listen to the right \_\_\_\_\_. **Eph.5:19**  
You will be tempted to listen to the world's music but.... **Psalm 40:8**
- We are told in the Bible that wrong friends will \_\_\_\_\_ our behavior. **1Cor.15:33**
- You will be tempted to hang out with the wrong friends. Prov.13:20

**Mark it down, every day the world, your flesh and the Devil will tempt you to sin and fail!**

**How do we keep from failing? The victory is found in the text verse above!**

1. Realize you are not alone in your temptation! ("...such as is common to man:")

2. Remember that God is always there! (“... **but God is faithful...**”)
3. God will never allow us to overwhelmed by the temptation. (“...**who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able...**”) He knows your weaknesses and strengths.
4. Remember that God always gives us a way to have victory over the temptation! (“... **but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear it.**”)





## Friday Devotion

### Following God's Will



God told Moses, send one ruler from each tribe of Israel into the land, look and report back. It was very simple. God was very clear about his will. He always is! Your parent's will is very clear at times: "Go tidy your room", "Time to come in for dinner". Like the twelve spies, you choose to obey or disobey. Ten of the spies decided that God's will was too much for them to do. God said he would give the land to Israel. Fear got the better of them instead of trusting God's perfect will. **How can we know God's will? Simple, God still tells us his will today.**

### **We find God's will for us in the Bible.**

**1Thes. 5:18** In every thing give thanks: for this is the \_\_\_\_\_ in Christ Jesus concerning \_\_\_\_\_.

**Rom. 12:2** And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your \_\_\_\_\_, that ye may prove what *is* that good, and acceptable, and perfect \_\_\_\_\_.

*God's will is very clear for us. There are no grey areas when God asks us to keep His commandments.*

### **We Must Read God's Word**

**2Tim. 2:15** \_\_\_\_\_ to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the \_\_\_\_\_.

**Psa. 1:2** But his delight *is* in the law of the LORD; and in his law doth he meditate day and night.

*You have to read it if you want to know God's will. Look and you will see commands - things to obey.*

### **We Must Believe God's Word.**

**John 3:7** \_\_\_\_\_ not that I said unto thee, ye \_\_\_\_\_ be born again.

**Num. 13:30** And Caleb stilled the people before Moses, and said, let us go up at once, and possess it; for we are well able to overcome it.

*Caleb and Joshua didn't hesitate to obey because they really believed God; do you?*

### **We Should Obey God's Will**

**1Pet. 2:13** \_\_\_\_\_ yourselves to every ordinance of man for the Lord's sake: whether it be to the king, as supreme;

**John 14:15** If ye love me, keep my commandments.

*If we believe God's word then we ought to obey it, Right? If you believe God then it should be easy to obey!*

### **We Must Not Be Frightened to Do God's Will.**

**Num. 13:31** But the men that went up with him said, We are not \_\_\_\_\_ to go up against the people; for they are stronger than we.

**2Tim. 1:7** For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.

*The 12 spies saw the land, but 10 got frightened because of what they saw. Look to God and do not fear.*

### **Look up Hebrews 12:1, 2**

- Lay aside every \_\_\_\_\_ . \_\_\_\_\_ – burdens that slow us down or hinder us from obeying God’s will! (ie. Wordly thinking, fear of man, can you think of any others?)
- Lay aside that \_\_\_\_\_ . \_\_\_\_\_ – Unbelief, lack of faith!

That \_\_\_\_\_ of unbelief is in us today as it was for the ten spies. We must have faith and trust God, and obey His Word!

### **Challenge:**

- What are the \_\_\_\_\_ holding you back in your life?
- Will you make up your mind to \_\_\_\_\_ God?
- Avoid failures by living by \_\_\_\_\_!
- You handle failures by keeping the focus on \_\_\_\_\_! (Heb. 12:1,2)

Will you make up your mind to do the will of God? Will you keep your eyes and focus on the Lord and not let those weights hinder you or slow you down in the race before you? Will you simply trust God and believe His word to the point of obedience? It is entirely up to you!


