


On the cross,

✓	Trial / Personal Struggle	What is God trying to change?
	The Will of God for my life – it may be not what you want to do. (Romans 12:1,2)	
	The Authority over my life – they may be hard to obey. (Hebrews 13:17)	
	I am too busy and have so little time for personal devotions and church activities (Matthew 6:33)	
	Financially I am struggling and my faith is weak about what to do (Proverbs 22:7)	
	My health is worrisome and keeps me self focused (2Corinthians 12:9)	
	Close people in my family worry me – they are not saved or are not living for God (Gal 4:19,20)	
	I have hurts from my past that keep coming up in my mind and keep me defeated (Philippians 3:13,14)	
	I have several big temptations that I so easily give in to (1Corinthians 10:13)	
	I have loads of doubts about my own salvation (2Corinthians 13:5)	
	I have lost my joy and the joy of serving the Lord and it scares me (Psalm 51:12)	
	I can't seem to let go of the friends in my life that are holding me back from living for God (Prov 13:20)	
	I find myself very lonely and can't seem to trust the Lord for a wife (Genesis 2:22; Psalm 37:4,5)
