# The Book of Hebrews Chapter Five

A High Priest Better Than Aaron

## I. Chapter Five Memory Verse:

Hebrews 5:9 "And being made perfect, he became the author of eternal salvation unto all them that obey him"

#### **II.** Lesson – Chapter Five

#### A. The Greatest High Priest Compared with Aaron (Heb 5:1-10)

- 1. Old Testament Priests and High Priests
  - a. Priests are only \_\_\_\_\_ no \_\_\_\_\_ priests
  - b. Chosen by God \_\_\_\_\_ Called of God
  - c. Ordained by God commissioned authorised
  - d. Their purpose is to \_\_\_\_\_
    - 1) Offer gifts
    - 2) Offer sacrifices
    - 3) Bring people back to God!
  - e. They are supposed to have compassion
    - 1) Because of their own weaknesses
    - 2) Because of their own sins and need for compassion themselves
  - f. It was a great honour to be a High Priest
  - g. Following the priestly pattern of \_\_\_\_\_
- 2. So also was Christ a Priest
  - a. He glorified/honoured not Himself
  - b. He was chosen as a man He had a human nature
  - c. As a Son
  - d. But, NOT following Aaron's order
    - 1) An order is a "\_\_\_\_\_
    - 2) Aaron's order had its own laws and regulations specific to it
  - e. But Jesus was following the order of Melchisedec a different set of laws, superior to Aarons not just different
  - f. Jesus remains a priest forever
- 3. Jesus was limited as a Man
  - a. He had "\_\_\_\_\_
  - b. He had to pray for things
    - 1) For wisdom before choosing the 12 apostles (Lk 6:12,13)
    - 2) As our High Priest (John 17)
  - c. He had times of strong crying
  - d. He was heard always was and will be heard!!!
- 4. Jesus is made a perfect High Priest (5:8-10)
  - a. He was tested, tried and proven
  - b. Though Jesus was a Son, yet He learned \_\_\_\_\_\_ By suffering

- c. He became the only author of eternal salvation, to all who follow HIM
- 5. Jesus was a High Priest like Melchisedec was (5:10)
  - a. Aaron was a failure
    - 1) Anger got him like it ruined his younger brother, Moses
    - 2) As a High Priest, he was still an idolater
    - 3) His family was a mess his two oldest boys were wicked and were killed by God
  - b. Melchisedec did not fail at least as recorded by the Bible!

## B. This is Strong Meat for a Jew (Heb 5:11-14)

- 1. There is so much to say about the order of Melchisedec more will be taught in chapter Seven
- 2. The truths about Melchisedec are hard to be taught because of the Jewish mindset
  - a. The Jews believed Aaron was the only priesthood forgot about Melchisedec
  - b. Thought the Old Covenant was all they needed forgot about the promise of a new covenant coming (Jer 31:31)
  - c. Thought the law was perfect and didn't need a better hope
  - d. These are things most every Jew STILL believes!
- 3. The problem with the Jewish reader of Hebrews:
  - a. "Dull" of hearing full of the teachings of every Rabbi
  - b. Immature not growing only stuck on "milk" (1Cor 3:1-3)
  - c. They were in need of starting all over and relearning
- 4. Only by \_\_\_\_\_ and testing / challenge can you grow to understand / discern good and evil doctrines! Having our senses, through instruction, exercise, and habit, brought to the place where we can recognize both good and evil.
- 5. What is the mark of full spiritual age?
  - a. Full age experience, time
  - b. Fully aware by all senses
  - c. Discernment of good and evil
- 6. The ability to distinguish good from evil is the power of judgment.
- 7. Milk and Meat Doctrines
  - a. Milk grace
    - 1) Forgiveness by the lamb
    - 2) Things you learn without really reading the Bible just from hearing it (5:13)
    - 3) Things that help you get started as a new baby and helps you grow
    - 4) The wrath of God
  - b. Meat
    - 1) Dispensations
    - 2) Melchidsedec priesthood versus the Aaronic priesthood
