



If your desire is to be trained to better serve the Lord as a layman or to prepare for a full-time ministry, you should consider Cork Bible Institute.





1. **Overview of the Old Testament.** This, along with the Overview of the New Testament, is the first class every believer should take to develop their understanding of the concepts and events of the Old Testament. It will help see the major themes and the important people of the Old Testament.
2. **The Gospel of Matthew I.** This is a verse-by-verse study of this most important Gospel! Every believer will find so many practical principles in this Gospel, and they will discover why God put it FIRST in the New Testament to be read and learned from!
3. **Baptist History & Distinctives.** What makes a church a Baptist Church? There are some very important and good differences between churches, and they are for good reason! This study course will explore what are the Bible based doctrines that a Baptist clings to, and why all churches should be Biblically Baptist!
4. **Doctrine of God (Theology).** This class explores the nature of God and is THE foundation of all other beliefs that a Christian should have!
5. **Children's Teacher Training I.** Every Teacher of Scripture feels inadequate, but with this class, they can know that they are focusing and learning the important ways to study in preparation to teach a children's Sunday School class. Things that will be explained and taught include the writing of lesson outlines, the use of visuals, puppets, songs and crafts. TEACHING SCHEDULE

We have structured the possible learning times from the weekly schedule of both the Bible Institute and Church sessions to get the most hours each week in study and learning.

- **Every Thursday 7-10pm IS THE MAIN CLASS TEACHING TIME.**
- **Sundays, 4:30pm-5:30** Preacher Workshop.
- **Sundays 6-7.30PM** – every student must take notes on the Sermon preached, or the Scripture passage taught and turn them in at the end of every Semester.
- **Wednesdays, 8-9PM** – There is a practical Verse by Verse Study of a Book, and students are encouraged to take notes for grading at the end of each Semester.

Most classes are recorded and available to be taken remotely via the website.

COST PER SEMESTER. €35 per course. Cork Bible Institute seeks to keep course fees very affordable. The only charges are course matriculation fees, designed to offset some of the immediate expenses. All other costs are underwritten by the Bible Baptist Church. Complete fees are due the first night of class each trimester. In addition to the course matriculation fee, the cost of any required textbooks is also the responsibility of the student. After the second week of class, no refund will be granted to any student withdrawing from a class.

HISTORY AND PURPOSE

Cork Bible Institute was established in 1999 to provide Christians with formal Bible training that is both practical, and effective in accomplishing our Lord's command to evangelize our world. It was designed to help Pastors, Missionaries, Sunday School Teachers, Church Workers, Deacons, Elders, Soul Winners, Parents and all Laymen rightly divide the Word of Truth.
