SONG (O Come All ye Faithful) NARRATOR (Caesar, Joseph, Mary)

And it came to pass in those days, that there went out a decree from Caesar Augustus, that all the world should be taxed. (And this taxing was first made when Cyrenius was governor of Syria.) And all went to be taxed, every one into his own city. And Joseph also went up from Galilee, out of the city of Nazareth, into Judaea, unto the city of David, which is called Bethlehem; (because he was of the house and lineage of David:) To be taxed with Mary his espoused wife, being great with child.

SONG (O Little Town of Bethlehem)

NARRATOR (Joseph, Mary, Innkeeper, Baby)

And so it was, that, while they were there, the days were accomplished that she should be delivered. And she brought forth her firstborn son, and wrapped him in swaddling clothes, and laid him in a manger; because there was no room for them in the inn.

NARRATOR (Angel of the Lord, Shepherds)

And there were in the same country shepherds abiding in the field, keeping watch over their flock by night. And, lo, the angel of the Lord came upon them, and the glory of the Lord shone round about them: and they were sore afraid. And the angel said unto them,

ANGEL OF THE LORD (Angel of the Lord, Shepherds)

"Fear not: for, behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy, which shall be to all people. For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Saviour, which is Christ the Lord. And this shall be a sign unto you; Ye shall find the babe wrapped in swaddling clothes, lying in a manger."

ALL ANGELS (Angel of the Lord, Angels, Shepherds)

"Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, good will toward men."

NARRATOR (Shepherds)

And it came to pass, as the angels were gone away from them into heaven, the shepherds said one to another,

SHEPHERD 1 (Shepherds)

"Let us now go even unto Bethlehem, and see this thing which is come to pass, which the Lord hath made known unto us."

SONG (It Came Upon a Midnight Clear)

NARRATOR (Joseph, Mary, Baby, Simeon)

And, behold, there was a man in Jerusalem, whose name was Simeon; and the same man was just and devout, waiting for the consolation of Israel: and the Holy Ghost was upon him. And it was revealed unto him by the Holy Ghost, that he should not see death, before he had seen the Lord's Christ. And he came by the Spirit into the temple: and when the parents brought in the child Jesus, to do for him after the custom of the law, Then took he him up in his arms, and blessed God, and said,

SIMEON (Joseph, Mary, Baby, Simeon)

"Lord, now lettest thou thy servant depart in peace, according to thy word: For mine eyes have seen thy salvation, Which thou hast prepared before the face of all people; A light to lighten the Gentiles, and the glory of thy people Israel."

NARRATOR (Joseph, Mary, Baby, Simeon)

NARRATOR (Joseph, Mary, Baby, Anna, Townspeople)

And there was one Anna, a prophetess, the daughter of Phanuel, of the tribe of Aser: she was of a great age, and had lived with an husband seven years from her virginity; And she was a widow of about fourscore and four years, which departed not from the temple, but served God with fastings and prayers night and day. Simeon leaves, and then Anna comes near and starts silently talking to Joseph and Mary. She then heads off to talk to the townspeople about Jesus!
